

## **The Kooples Phone-In for Angora Rabbits on 19 February**

Thank you for taking part in our call-in to urge The Kooples to stop selling angora.

Here are some guidelines about what to say:

- Ask to speak to the store manager.
- Say that you are calling because you're concerned about The Kooples' failure to ban angora, an unethical product which causes animals immense suffering.
- If you have ever bought anything from The Kooples, mention that you are a former customer but will no longer be shopping there because of this issue.
- The person on the phone may tell you that the store is not currently selling angora. Ask them if this is a permanent, company-wide ban and if they will be issuing a written statement about it.
- Ask the person on the other end to pass on your comments to their manager.
- Make sure you get your point across clearly while staying polite.
