We hope our memorial will let people know that the best way to prevent crashes such as this one is to go vegan, because pigs shouldn't have to make terrifying trips to abattoirs at all. It will also remind lorry drivers of their responsibility to the thousands of animals they haul every year as well as to the motorists whose lives are endangered when a lorry crashes.
