



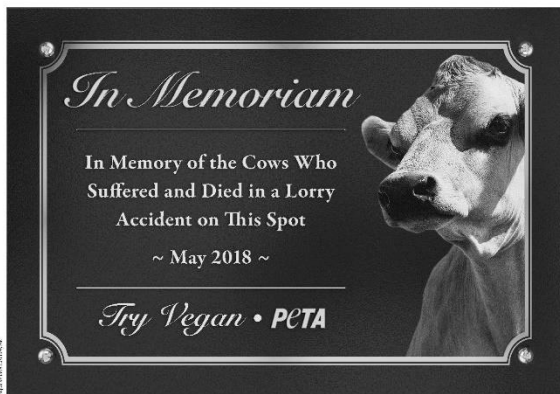

Following the recent crash on Cant's Drove, near Murrow, in which around 20 cows were killed when the lorry carrying them overturned, I'm writing to ask whether you'd please permit PETA to place a [memorial](#) near the accident site to commemorate the lives lost.



Our memorial would let people know that the best way to prevent crashes such as this one is to go vegan – because cows shouldn't have to make a terrifying journey, likely to the abattoir, at all. It'd also remind lorry drivers who transport animals of their responsibility to the thousands of living beings they haul every year as well as to the motorists whose lives are endangered when a trailer overturns.
