As you may know, there was recently a crash on the A24 in which a lorry overturned on the northbound carriageway at Dial Post, near Horsham. The accident resulted in the tragic deaths of 60 sheep who were being transported in the lorry. I'm writing to ask if you'd please permit PETA to place a memorial near the accident site to commemorate the lives lost in this incident.

Our memorial would let people know that the best way to prevent crashes such as this one is to go vegan, sparing many sheep a terrifying trip to the livestock market or abattoir every year. It'd also remind lorry drivers of their responsibility to the thousands of animals they carry every year as well as to the motorists whose lives are endangered when a heavy goods vehicle overturns.
