

Dear Councillor:

Following the recent crash on the A5 in Gobowen which resulted in the death of seven cows, I'm writing to ask you to permit People for the Ethical Treatment of Animals (PETA) to place a memorial near the accident site to commemorate the lives lost.



Our memorial would let people know that the best way to prevent crashes such as this one, which likely happened on the way to an abattoir, is to go vegan – because cows shouldn't have to make such terrifying journeys at all. It would also remind lorry drivers who transport animals of their responsibility to the thousands of living, feeling beings they haul every year and to the motorists whose lives are endangered when a lorry overturns.
