As warmer weather brings British beer lovers to pubs to revel in freedom and friendship, hundreds of thousands of clever rats are languishing in laboratories across the UK, denied freedom and liberty. Because your Key Lime Pie Sour, *Lab Rat*, normalises this cruel use of rats in experimentation, we're requesting you to rename this beer "The Organoid".

Modern, humane, and more scientifically-relevant than using animals, an organoid is a 3D minature model system grown from human cells to mimic human organs. It's just one of the <u>many animal-free advances</u> that allow science to produce more human-relevant data without subjecting animals to cruel poisonings, surgical mutilations, electrocutions, and more.

Unlike inanimate tissues, rats are thinking and feeling individuals, each with a unique personality. They exhibit altruistic behaviour, acting with empathy toward other rats. They emit squeals of joy when happy, purr via teeth chattering when they're content, and have superb memories. A rat can even recall up to 30 events, with context!

Sadly, in the UK, rats are common victims of the over 2.68 million experimental procedures performed on animals each year.
